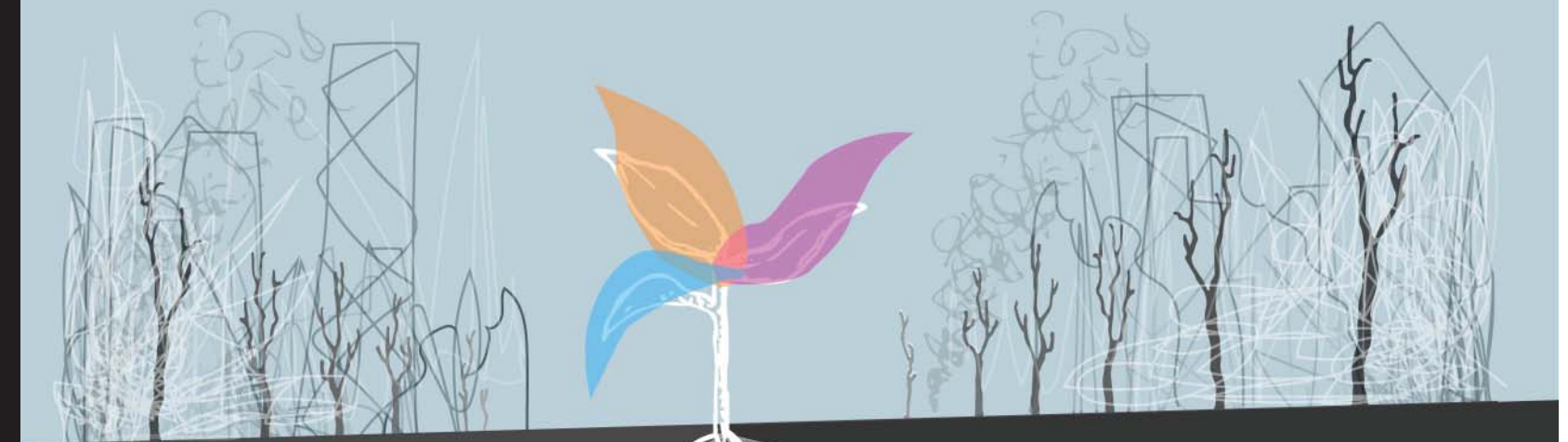

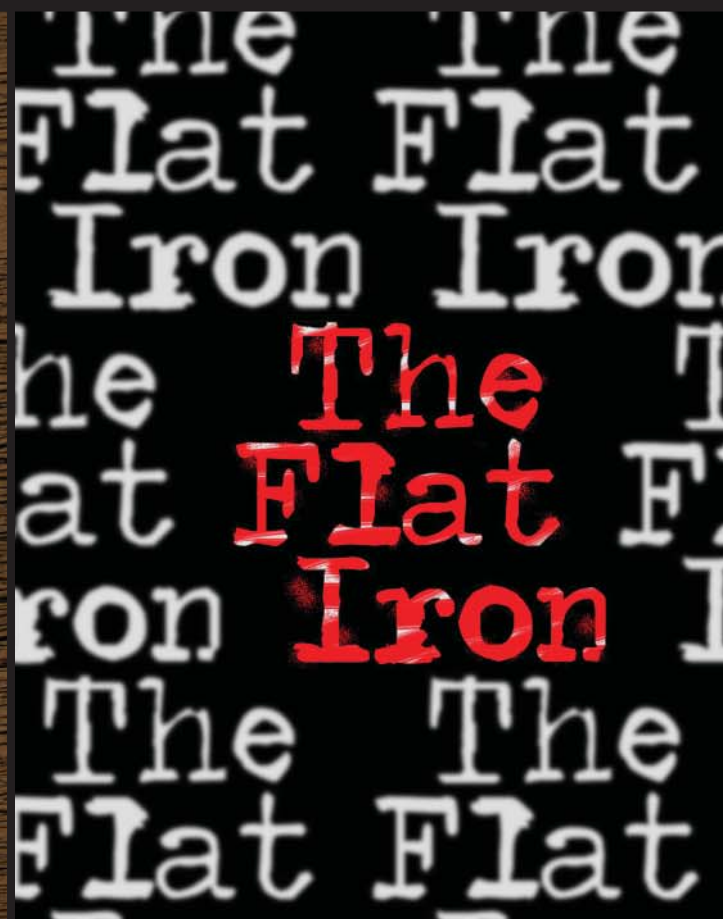

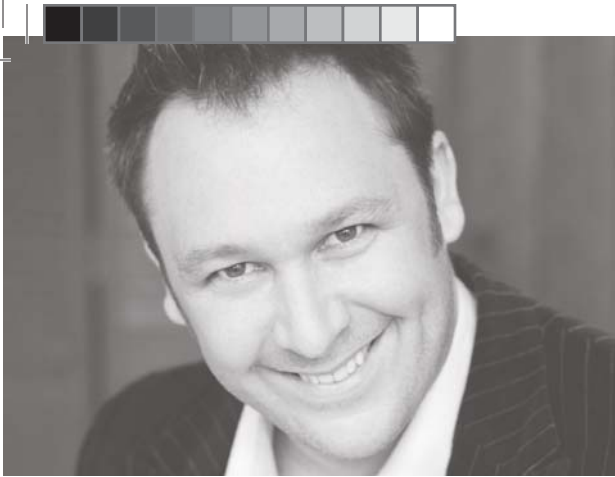

artistic and executive director

ANTHONY MOSELEY

Welcome to the 14th Annual SKETCHBOOK Festival.

This year's submissions were asked to submit new works of 0-3 minutes, 4-7 minutes, or 8-20 minutes. In line with Collaboration's evolved Mission, they were prompted to explore the most critical social issues of our times. Curator Ike Holter noticed the theme of "history repeating" in the work. We asked the question "what if history were to finally stop repeating?" What if...

...on the night before the first preview of the 14th Annual SKETCHBOOK Festival, a Revolution began. What if there was a total economic collapse followed by a blackout, and we had to postpone the festival indefinitely. We covered up the costumes, props, set, lighting and sound boards, and we told the artists to go and be with their families, hopefully we would all return soon to share these 17 new short plays about the most critical social issues of 2014.

And what if in 2021, after seven years of Global war, it ended and a new world-wide governing body, the Global Union, was established. The GU picked 72 Global Hubs and inventoried all global resources and began to equally distribute throughout the world. And they made oil illegal, animals sacred and started the HEFA program to provide every Human on Earth Housing, Education, Food, and Arts. What if, by 2045, poverty, famine and cancer were on the verge of elimination.

And perhaps, in 2049, the GU then sends recovery and restoration teams into buildings that had been closed since the Revolution, one of which is the Flat Iron Arts Building in Chicago, the former home of a provocative, multi-disciplinary theatre company called Collaboration that was intent on using theatre to incite awareness and change.

Thank you for joining us and enjoy the theatrical time capsule we call The Times of Our Lives.

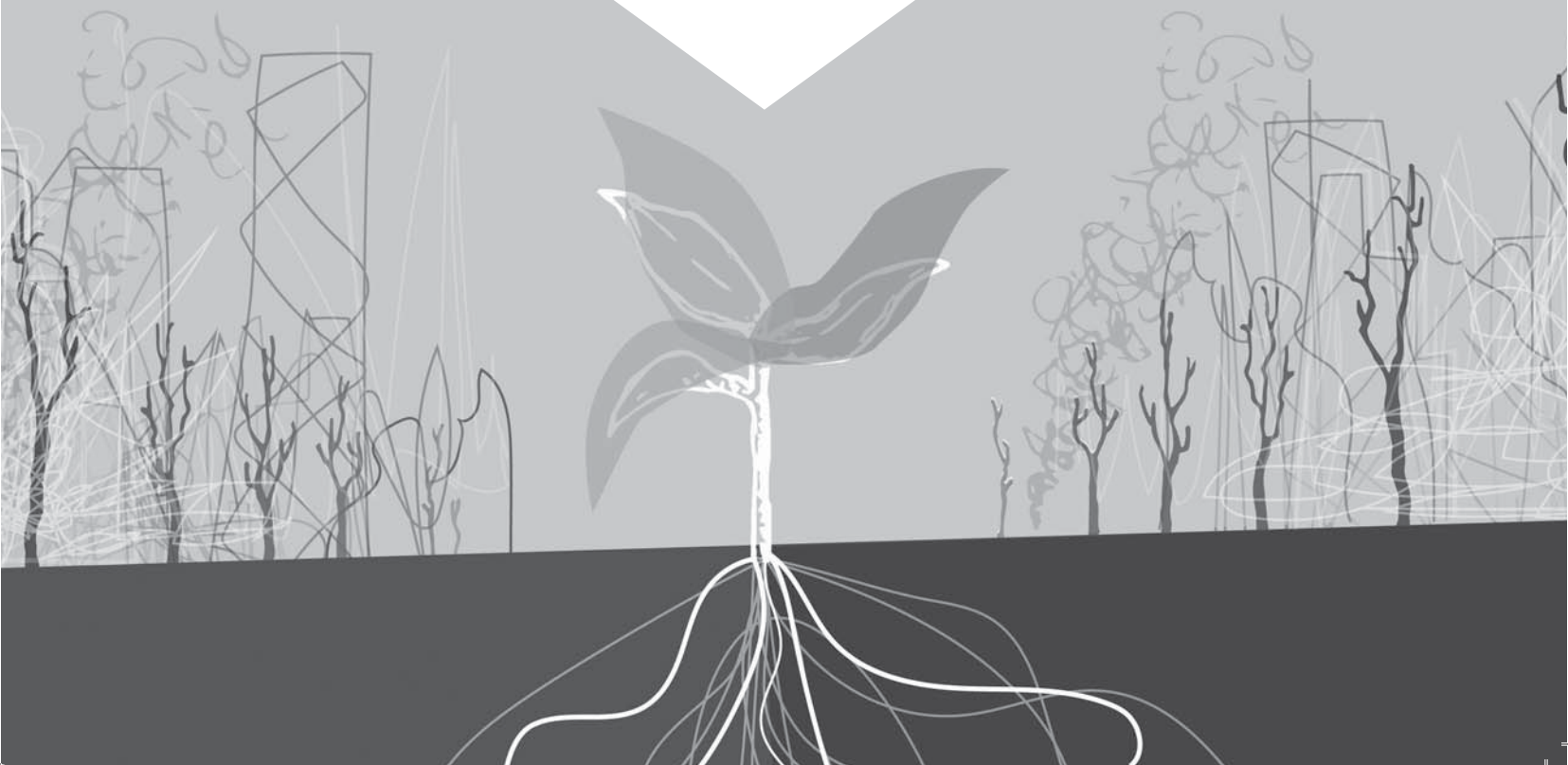

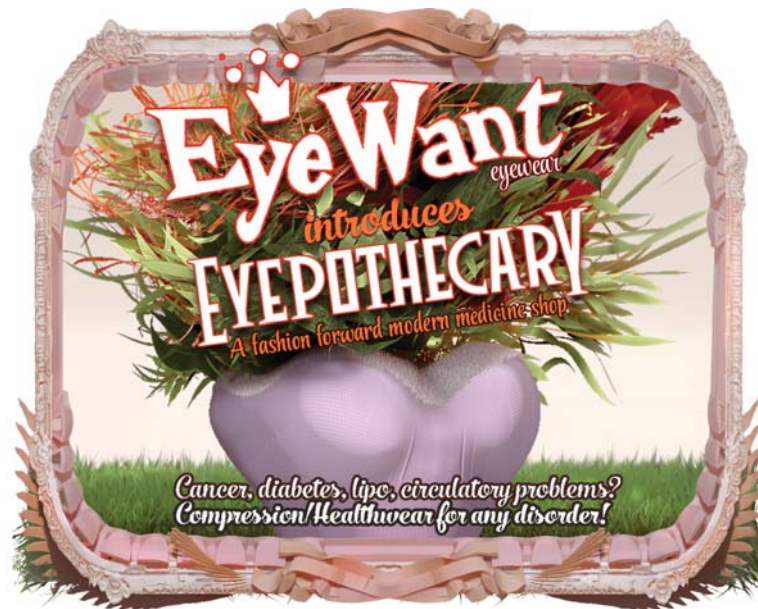
